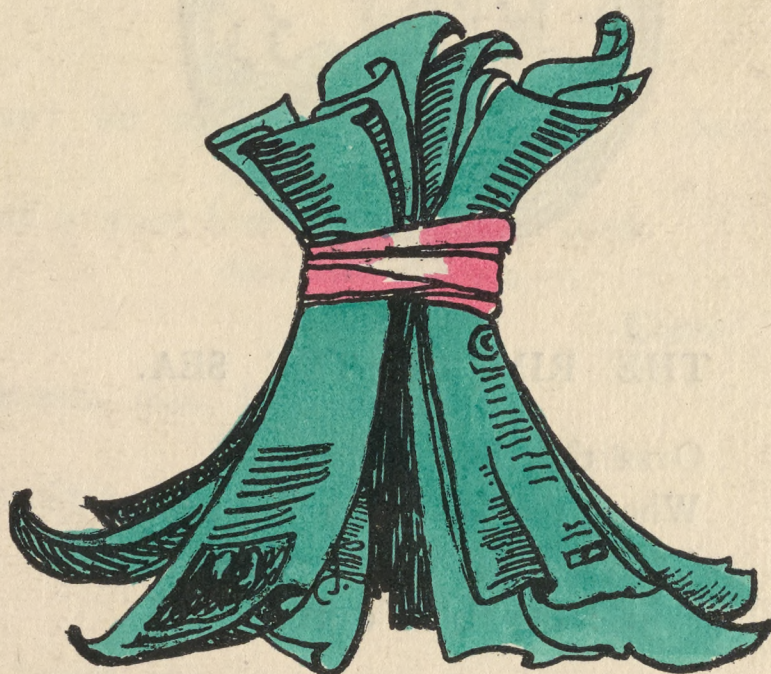


The Green Sheaf
